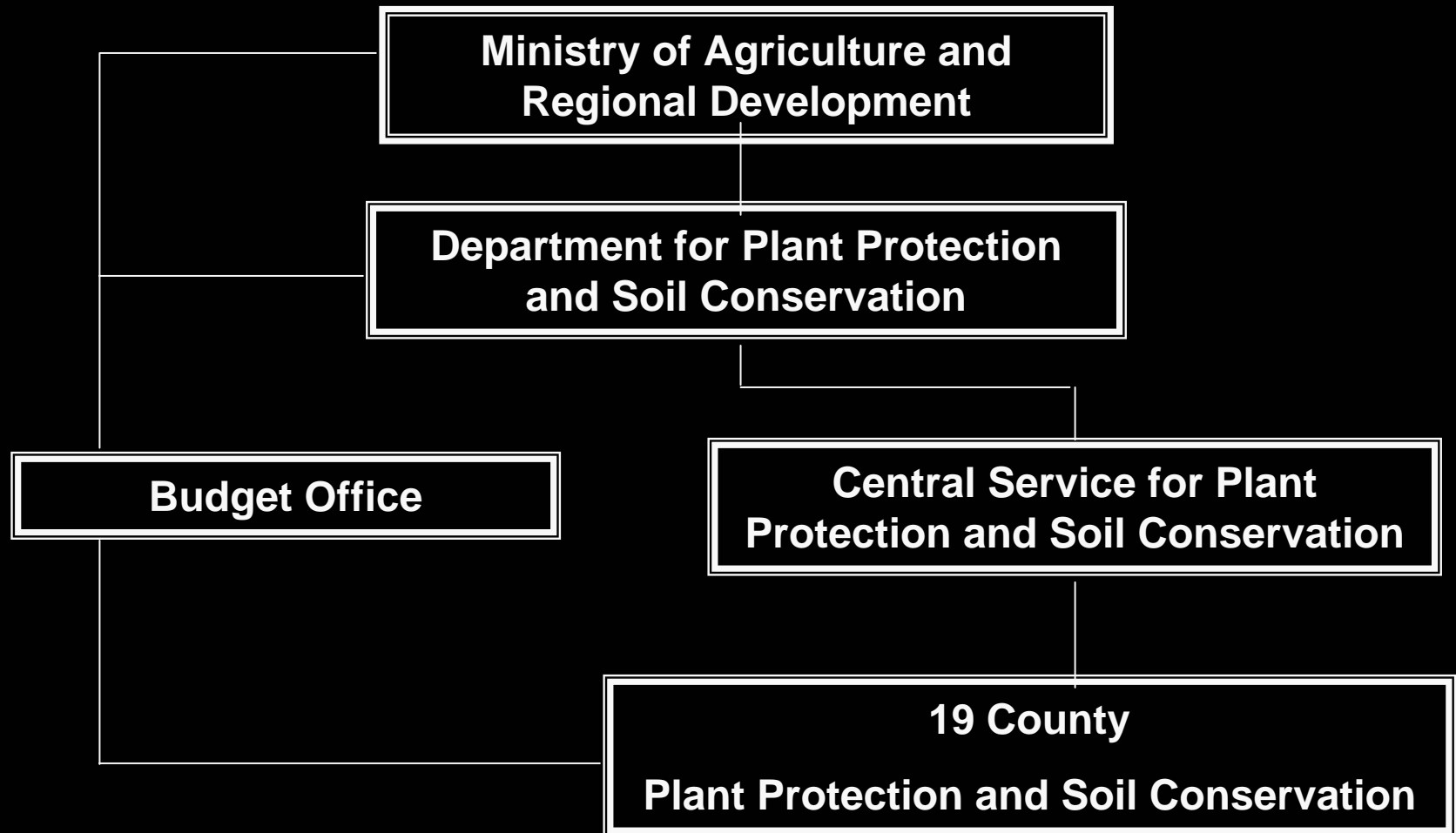

# Responsibilities and main tasks of the MARD – Department for Plant protection and Soil Conservation

- Coordinating and implementing of plant health tasks
- Establishment of plant protection and soil conservation legislations, regulations
- Establishing compliance with international standards
- International relations, agreements, membership (IPPC, WTO, SPS)
- Approval of the annual programs
- Planning of the financial resources
- Direct and supervise the National service through the Central Service
- Approval of the annual training

# Budget

- Government budget, fees of official inspections and fees for other services
- 25-30% Government contribution
- For investments –individual state subsidy/PHARE co-financing
- Budget Office -FKI /veterinary, agricultural and forestry offices/
- On the base of the planed additional tasks and requirement of the Department /guidelines of the Ministry of Finance/

## Plant health:

MARD- 1 graduate specialist is responsible for plant health

Central service- 5 graduates, 1 middle-grade administrator

County services- almost 300 plant protection inspectors /graduated

# Training

- Quarterly meetings of chief inspectors
- Annual training of chief inspectors
- Three day regional training for plant protection inspectors
- Three day training for inspectors at BIPs
- Training of inspectors dealing with propagating material
